Program Highlight

Partnering with the West Virginia Council of Churches and the REACH Initiative RCCR hired Patsy DiCesare as a Reentry Case Manager to help justice impacted individuals find safe, affordable housing. In 2022, Patsy successfully housed 53 justice impacted individuals.

"My name is Randi and RCCR has played a big role in my success in recovery. I spent 4 months in South Central Regional Jail before being moved to a long-term Inpatient Rehabilitation Program. Nearing the end of my time there I was introduced to Patsy DiCesare. Before him I had spent a couple of months trying to find an apartment but was unsuccessful due to my pending felony charges. Patsy was able to find me a nice apartment and paid for all moving expenses. Patsy and RCCR have gone above and beyond with helping me get on my feet. I know that without RCCR's help I would not be where I am today. I thank God for guiding me to Patsy and RCCR. I am blessed to have him as a part of my support network."





Financials Performance*


Total Revenue: \$1,558,883.86
